- **Getting to know each other:** Games, icebreakers, interactive panels and small group discussion sessions to learn about and understand each other.

## OPTION 1: YOUTH-TO-YOUTH



- Meet Jewish, Christian, and Muslim youth from Jerusalem
- Participate in educational workshops together as youth
- Learn new perspectives
- Find out what its like to grow up in the face of violence

***YOUTH-to-YOUTH is an interactive program for tour groups to engage Israeli and Palestinian youth growing up as active members in an interfaith community of peacemakers in Jerusalem. Youth for this program range from ages 14-25 and come from Israeli and Palestinian communities throughout Jerusalem and the West Bank.***

- Meet Israeli & Palestinian leaders of a peace movement
- Ask all of the tough questions
- Understand other perspectives
- Think critically about your own relationship to "the other" in your community at home
